### Tasting Note

The 2018 vintage is the result of a brilliant partnership between English wine creators David Rowledge and Peter Moorhouse and their winemaking business partner, Boris Kovac.

This delicious rose comes from the foothills of the Montagne Noire in the South of France, under the influence of the Mediterranean climate. After delicate crushing and destemming, this charming Syrah / Grenache Rosé blend is made from free run gentle press juice. The juice is fermented at low temperatures to maintain flavour and layers of complexity.

The wine is pale in colour and is full of red summer fruit aromas of strawberries and raspberries. The hints of cherry and spice on the palate lead to a crisp, long, refreshing finish.

### Serving & Dining

Serve at 8c. Great as an aperitif and perfect for hot weather drinking. Will pair very well with light salads, light pasta and rice dishes, especially with seafood or shellfish, and with grilled fish and goats cheese.
